In response to a long standing prayer of the local people for establishment of a Rural Health Care Centre at Mouldanga village took off with appropriate enthusiasm and colour on 18 June, 2017 morning. The Foundation Stone laying ceremony of Nabaneepa Memorial Rral Health Care Centre was arranged within the Ashram premises. Binapani Ashram opted to dedicate the health centre in memory of Late Nabaneepa Chaudhuri, who left us for her heavenly abode at an immature age of 23 years. Daughter of Anup and Madhumita Chaudhuri of Kalikapur, Kolkata, Nabaneepa was a graduate engineer, serving in a corporate business house, became an unfortunate victim of Emperor of all diseases, called Cancer. In fond memory of the child, her parents came forward to extend necessary financial support to establish and further run the facility in association with the Binapani Ashram Trust.

The Foundation stone has been laid by Honourable Principal of Calcutta National Medical College, Dr. Manjusree Ray. Before the Foundation Stone laying ceremony, Dr. Manjusree Ray was warmly received by the Ashram organisers and resident girls of Binapani Ashram along with other invited Doctors , present at the venue, who came to participate in the day long general health camp, organised by the Trust. It was nice to find Dr. M.N. Ray, a reputed Orthopaedic surgeon, a former Faculty from Calcutta Medical College and husband of Dr. Manjusree Ray among us and participating in the health camp. Our Chief Guest on the occasion Dr. Manjusree Ray was remarkably eloquent towards our endeavour and expressed her sincere love and respect for the commitment, made by the organisers of Binapani Ashram for '*Changing lives*' of the poor and hapless. In fact she has also adopted a resident girl child of class one standard for her education, health care and cultural up lift.

It has been decided that at present the ground floor of the proposed three storied building will be used for the health care facility. The upper floors may come up with further generation of funds from public and corporate CSR support. Through this report the Trust Board request our friends and well wishers to support the noble cause with money and material, to enable the authority to complete and run the project successfully for the interest of the poorer section of our community. The Trust authority gratefully acknowledges the Chaudhuri family for sponsoring the Foundation Stone laying ceremony, followed by lunch and all associated activities of the day.

Let's pray that our endeavour fulfils our desire to establish a health service centre.
