

A HOME AWAY FROM HOME: BINAPANI ASHRAM

Binapani Educational and Welfare Trust was formally registered by a Deed of Trust at the office of the Addl. Sub-registrar, Bolpur, bearing Deed no. 1730, dated, 21 March, 1997. The initiative came from Barka and his wife, Manjusree Saren in order to provide formal education, health care and cultural uplift to poor tribal children of the local villages and of underprivileged families of neighbouring areas.

More than two decades after, the institution continues to grow and evolved as it pursues its goal of empowering local tribal children, especially girls, by making them more self-reliant through comprehensive programmes. Those are generally, formal education, vocational training and enrichment activities which are helping them assimilate in to main stream life of the land. True to the founders' vision, Binapani Ashram has provided quality welfare services to an increasing number of first generation learners since its inception as a registered Trust in 1997. It is important to note that **Binapani Ashram is a registered Public Charitable Trust**, and not an orphanage or govt. aided destitute home. *The Ashram identifies itself in being an educational support system, intended for Women's empowerment and runs exclusively through individual and corporate support.*

Anyone, who identifies with the goal and objectives, is welcome to join the Trust as a sponsor, a volunteer, a voluntary instructor at the Ashram school or as fund raiser for the organisation.

Further, in addition to the education and training programmes, the organisers have created facilities for general health care, a modern Dental and Eye care units offering services for the poor. OPD medical units are attended by qualified doctors. Treatment is free of cost for the Ashram children and local villagers.

ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE LAST TWENTY YEARS:

1. An English medium primary school, Binapani Memorial Academy (the institution needs to be operational after Covid 19).
2. Pre-primary school, styled as Indrani Basu Memorial Nursery School for the children of age group between 3 and 6 years of local village.
3. Providing free accommodation and highly subsidised food for school going girls of under privileged families, especially from tribal communities.
4. Smart Class room, online instruction facilities, well-stocked library and computer application training offered to the resident girls of Binapani Ashram.
5. Offering scholarships to meritorious girls and especially students pursuing science courses in higher education.
6. General and specialised health services for girls in Dental and Eye care centres within the Ashram premises.
7. Special Yoga practices and appearing in competitions for the Ashram girls.
8. Ashram based Horticulture and homestead gardening awareness for Girls and their parents.
